

Creating DOM nodes in jQuery

- Create new with raw HTML (not recommended)
 - `$("<div id='somediv' class='someclass'>")`
- Clone from an existing element
 - `$("#someelement").clone()`
- Create new by chaining
 - `$("<div>").attr("id", "somediv")`
`.attr("class", "someclass")`
- Note that many javascript functions take in arrays of keyword arguments, so this also works:
 - `$("<div>").attr({ "id" : "somediv", "class" : "someclass" })`

Inserting DOM nodes in jQuery

- Append as child (last or first) under parent with id *parent*
 - `$("#parent").append(<new_node>)`
 - `$("#parent").prepend(<new_node>)`
- Append as sibling to element with id *element*
 - `<new_node>.insertAfter($("#element")`
 - `<new_node>.insertBefore($("#element"))`
