SUBMISSION PROCEDURE:

An electronic version of the manuscript must be submitted in MS Word to Ahmad Tootoonchi, Chief Editor at <u>tootoonchi@utm.edu</u>. Upon completion of a review by expert scholars who serve as part of the *IJIR* review board, the first author will be informed of acceptance or rejection of the paper within a four month timeframe from the submission date. If the paper is accepted, the first author will receive a formal letter of acceptance along with the registration form and guidelines for publication of papers in the *IJIR*.

In the Registration form, the author (s) testify that the aforementioned article has not been published in any other publication, and will not be submitted for publication in any other journal after its print in *IJIR*.
