To be admitted to the **Construction Management Certificate program** with clear admission status, prospective candidates must first meet all requirements for graduate admission to UT Rio Grande Valley, as well as the other requirements listed below:

- Bachelor's degree in civil engineering, construction engineering and management, or architecture.
- Undergraduate GPA of at least 3.0 in the last 60 semester credit hours.
