## PHP forms and form processing Assignment

1.- Write an HTML file with a form, and one or more PHP scripts that let you upload a file to the Web Server.

2.- Email a .zip file <your\_name>.zip containing your HTML file and PHP script(s) to: [ivan.amayavazquez01@utrgv.edu](mailto:ivan.amayavazquez01@utrgv.edu)

Some things of note:

- You need to use the POST method.
- You have to use the enctype attribute of the form element and set it to: "multipart/form-data" in order to upload the file.
- Set the action attribute of the form element to the PHP script you want to run, which contains the code to upload a file.
- Once you submit the form, all the info needed to upload the file is placed inside the \$\_FILES super global array.
- You can use the built-in PHP function 'move\_uploaded\_file' to move the uploaded file to a destination (the same folder where the script resides, perhaps).
