Job Summary:

The mission of the Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) is to promote and support a workforce system that creates value and offers employers, individuals and communities the opportunity to achieve and sustain economic prosperity. To support our mission, we are looking for a Systems Analyst IV to join the UI Operations and Customer Support Department team. The position will be located in one of the TWC UI Tele-Centers (El Paso, Fort Worth, McAllen, San Antonio) or in UI Operations and Customer Support (Austin North Lamar Administration Building).

The Systems Analyst IV performs highly complex (senior-level) computer systems analysis work. Work involves planning and analyzing user requirements, procedures, and problems to automate processing or to improve existing systems. May assign and/or supervise the work of others. Works under limited supervision, with considerable latitude for the use of initiative and independent judgment.

General Duties:

- Coordinates and plans activities during all phases of the System Development Life Cycle (SDLC).
- Oversees and provides guidance in troubleshooting and coordinates training to other UI support staff on a variety of software applications.
- Oversees the preparation of various reports and test data.
- Analyzes and tests procedures and systems to ensure that all applications are efficient and effective for vital business operations.
- Designs, modifies, and implements structured programs and systems appropriate to customer needs.
- Prepares and defines system diagrams and thorough instructions describing logical operational steps of programs suitable for different audiences.
- Coordinates, plans, and schedules the installation of test plans using approved testing methods and tools.
- Oversees user acceptance testing to ensure programming enhancements or developments meet business requirements.
- Communicates effectively and works closely with users to analyze business requirements and assists in aiding in decisions on computer systems modifications and implementations.
- Ensures that applications and reports meet agency coding, design work products consistently meet coding, design, and project-specific standards.
- May assist in the design, development, and maintenance of assigned applications and systems.
- May assign and supervise the work of others.
- Work is performed under limited supervision, with considerable latitude for the use of initiative and independent judgment.
- Performs related work as assigned.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Experience with the following software development kits, tools and languages preferred, such as: Eclipse IDE, Microsoft Visual Studio, Microsoft Visual Basic .NET (VB.NET), C#, Microsoft SQL Server, Internet Information Services (IIS), JavaScript, JQuery, Ajax, HTML, CSS, ASP.net.
- Maintains, defines, and develops secure multi-user client/server solutions that integrate with backend SQL servers, IBM DB2, and Microsoft Access.
- Strongly preferred experience includes developing and maintaining applications and systems in Microsoft VB.NET and C# that integrate with Microsoft SQL Server.
- Able to work quickly while balancing many high priority tasks concurrently.
- Able to work in a collaborative team coding environment.



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Minimum Qualifications:

Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university, plus two years of full-time experience in computer programming, systems analysis and/or program analysis or two years of full-time experience which provided general knowledge of data processing or systems analysis, one year of which must have been in a supervisory or administrative management capacity.

Fifteen semester hours of accredited college work in computer science may be substituted for each year of the required experience. One additional year of full-time qualifying experience may be substituted for each year (30 semester hours) of the required education.

Duty requires up to 25% travel (within the state of Texas) and the ability to lift 25 pounds.

The salary for this position is \$4,301.16 - \$4,986.00 per month, depending on qualifications.
